OUTSTANDING JUVENILE OFFICER

This award is given to an outstanding Peace Officer, as determined by the awards committee, who specializes in working with youth in the State of Minnesota. Only sworn full-time officers licensed by the State of Minnesota are eligible for consideration for this award. The following criteria may be considered in determining the award.

- The nominee must be a licensed full time peace officer in good standing with the Minnesota Peace Officer and Standards and Training Board.
- The nominee must have demonstrated above and beyond the call of their regular assignment, their willingness to work toward the betterment of youth in the State of Minnesota.
- Supporting documentation from supervisor's, school staff, community leaders, etc. will assist in awards committee in making the final selection.

OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD

This award is given to non-sworn nominees who specialize in working with youth. Both public and private entities, and or individuals, may make nominations to the awards committee. To assist the awards committee in making the final selection, please attach supporting documentation from supervisors, community leaders, etc.

Nominations must be received no later than December 14th of the calendar year. The winning nominee(s) will be notified of their selection during the first two weeks of January prior to the Annual Conference, and they will be invited to attend the annual conference to receive the award.
